IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

---

To amend Title 18 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations to authorize the Director to grant residential parking privileges to residents of private streets that abut streets with residential parking restrictions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Motor Vehicle Residential Parking Regulation Amendment Act of 2000".

Sec. 2. Subsection 2413.4 of Title 18 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations is amended to read as follows: DCMR

"2413.4 The Director may issue a residential permit parking sticker, upon application and payment of the fee established pursuant to §2415, to a motor vehicle owner who resides on:

"(a) Property abutting a block designated as a residential permit parking street which is not eligible for residential permit parking because of existing parking restrictions, but which is surrounded by streets which have been designated as residential permit parking streets or have other restrictions which prohibit all day parking; or

"(b) A private street which is not eligible for residential permit parking because of its roadway designation."

Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code § 1-233(c)(3)).

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), approval by the Financial Responsibility and Management Assistance Authority as provided in section 203(a) of the District of Columbia Financial Responsibility and Management Assistance Act of 1995, approved April 17, 1995 (109 Stat. 116; D.C. Code § 47-392.3(a)), a 30-day period of Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
