A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

Councilmember McDuffie introduced the following bill, which was referred to the Committee on _____.

To provide to residents age 65 years and older a free recycling cart and trash can at the time the senior relocates to or within in the District of Columbia; and to provide a one-time free of charge replacement recycling cart and trash can.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Supercans for Seniors Act of 2013".

Sec. 2. The Department of Public Works shall provide to residents age 65 years and older the following, at no cost to the resident:

- (a) At the time of relocating to or within in the District of Columbia:
 - (1) one new 32-gallon recycling cart; and
 - (2) one new 32-gallon or 96-gallon trash can, per the resident's request.

(b) Upon the destruction or disappearance of a government-issued recycling cart or trash can, a one-time replacement of each container.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal

4 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
5 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as
6 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
7 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
8 Columbia Register.
