

A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

Councilmember Muriel Bowser introduced the following bill, which was referred to the Committee on _____.

To accept the dedication of land for the realignment of Spring Place, N.W. in Squares 3185 and 3186 in order to accommodate the extension of the Metropolitan Branch Trail within such squares.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,
That this act may be cited as the “Dedication of Land for Street Purposes (S.O. 13-_____) Act of 2013.”

Sec. 2(a) Pursuant to sections 302(c) of the Street and Alley Closing and acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §9-203.02(3)) (“Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act”), the Council accepts the dedication, in fee simple absolute, of the land necessary for the realignment of Spring Place, N.W. in Squares 3185 and 3186, as shown on the Surveyor’s plat in S.O. File 13-_____.

(b) Pursuant to section 302(c) of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act (D.C. Official Code § 9-203.02(3)), and notwithstanding the requirement set forth in section 304 (D.C. Official Code § 9-203.04), that in any one block length a

1 minor street shall be 75 feet wide, the Council accepts the dedication of land necessary to
2 widen Spring Place, N.W., as shown on the Surveyor's Plat filed under S.O. 13-_____).

3 (c) Pursuant to section 401 of the of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition
4 Procedures Act, the land dedicated in subsection (a) of this section shall become part of
5 Spring Place, N.W.

6 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

7 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Chief Financial Officer as
8 the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia
9 Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-
10 206.02(c)(3)).

11 Sec. 4. The Secretary of the Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its
12 effective date, each to the Office of the Mayor, the Office of the Surveyor of the District
13 of Columbia, and the District of Columbia Recorder of Deeds.

14 Sec.5. Effective date.

15 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto
16 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of
17 Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home
18 Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-
19 206.02(c)(1)), and publication the District of Columbia Register.
