Councilmember Phil Mendelson, Chairman of the Committee on Public Safety and the Judiciary, announces a public oversight roundtable on a Follow Up on Capital Projects and Space Needs for Public Safety Agencies. The public oversight roundtable will be held at 12:30 p.m. on October 26, 2007 in Hearing Room 123 of the John A. Wilson Building.

The purpose of this roundtable is to hear testimony from government witnesses that follows up on the previous public roundtable held on September 20, 2007 on the status of various capital projects and space needs related to public safety agencies such as the Metropolitan Police Department, the Office of Administrative Hearings, and the Department of Corrections.
